

Judging Schedule – 22nd Annual “Hounds for the Holidays” AKC Agility Trial

EXHIBITORS PLEASE READ THIS THOROUGHLY!!

SITE RULES: The building will be open at 6:15 am each day, & judging will start at 8:30 am on Thursday & 8 am the other days. The upper parking lot entrance is to the upstairs of the front of the building. The exercise area is off the downstairs ring area, out the doors between the rings. This is where the lower parking lot entrance is also. **DO NOT USE THE FRONT UPSTAIRS ENTRANCE AS AN EXERCISE AREA!!** This includes people walking their dogs into the building – male dogs should NOT be allowed to mark ANYTHING in front. Control your dogs please! **Anyone witnessed allowing their dogs to relieve themselves off this front upstairs entrance will be subject to expulsion from the trial with no refund.** The back door (past the unused ring) is NOT to be used to potty dogs.

Flexi leashes are allowed at the trial, but they are NOT ALLOWED TO BE EXTENDED inside the building. Please watch your dogs at all times when they are outside their crates, and do not allow them to invade other dogs' spaces. If you cannot pay full attention to your dog (such as when you're shopping, talking, eating, watching), please leave them in the crate.

CRATING RULES: There is plenty of room for crating if people do not take up unreasonable amounts of space. There are new people coming every day – be considerate & leave room for them. **There will be NO crates, dogs or people in the unused ring!** Crating is allowed in the upstairs Conference Center area if a quieter environment, or proximity to the upper lot, are desired.

Crating areas will be marked. Crates/belongings outside these areas **will be moved** by the Trial Committee. Please stack crates whenever possible. **Ground mats are NOT ALLOWED** except completely inside ex-pens.

There will be limited crating inside the ring boards but **ONLY** for dogs who do not bark. If you crate inside the boards and your dog barks, it WILL BE MOVED!

SECURITY: **We will NOT have private security personnel.** This means you **MUST** be **VERY CAREFUL** about locking vehicles and keeping any and all valuables with you. The club and the soccer center are not responsible for any losses occurring on the grounds.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT SET UP: Exhibitors who wish to set up their crates Wednesday night can do so **ONLY** if they help to unload the equipment and set up the ring gating and obstacles **FIRST**. **Equipment unloading will start at 6:00pm. If there is any change in time, it will be posted to creamcitycanines.com by Tuesday night.**

CHECK-IN/MEASURING: If your dog needs to be measured, you will need to get that done before your first run at the trial. There will be 2 VMOs available for height card measuring. **Practice measuring ahead of time to expedite the process, & bring treats with you.**

Please check in with the gate steward immediately after you have completed your walk through of the course, if not earlier. Conflicts should be communicated at that time. Please be considerate to the workers and your fellow exhibitors!

Groups may be split for walking courses. We know there will be conflicts with the opposite ring, but everyone will get their walks and runs. Please exhibit your holiday spirit of patience and cooperation to get through the days, and remember that we do this for FUN! Smile & be nice to everyone, including yourself & your dog.

INFO/RIBBON TABLE: Is on the lower level between the restrooms. Scores, ribbons, moveups, refund checks, and measurements are found here.

Ribbons/result labels will be self-serve and will be available once the judge has released the results.

Master QQ ribbons, New Title ribbons, & MACH/PACH rosettes will be available all days.

Score for classes in progress will be on computer monitors. Completed class/height scores will be in the binders at the info table.

WORKERS: The worker signup grid is available at the link on the creamcitycanines.com website. Some blanks have been filled in – please sign yourself up!! Workers will get a wristband for lunch access, and worker raffle tickets, from the Ring Captains. Course Builders will get their tickets from the Chief Coursebuilder of the day/ring. **Worker lunch wristbands must be worn to obtain lunch!**

COURSEBUILDING: Coursebuilders please listen to the overhead PA for request for course builds. There will be several course builds per day. **NO tweaking the course once the judge has OK'd it!!**

FOOD/VENDORS: The Soccer Park has excellent concessions for sale all days. All concessions and vendors are upstairs on the mezzanine.

RAFFLE TABLES: Charge Against Cancer will hold a daily raffle on Thursday and Friday, and Wisconsin Border Collie Rescue will hold a daily raffle on Saturday and Sunday. The raffle tables will be located on the mezzanine. Please support these great causes and purchase raffle tickets each day.

DIRECTIONS: *From north (Green Bay) or south (Chicago):* I-43 to Good Hope Rd (exit #80). West 4 miles to site.

From west (Madison): I-94 to US 45. North ~8 mi to Good Hope Rd. East 2.5 miles to site.

From northwest (Fond du Lac): US 45 to Good Hope Rd. East 2.5 miles to site.

From southwest (Rockford): I-43 north to US 45. North ~13 miles to Good Hope Rd. East 2.5 miles to site.

EMERGENCY VET: Lakeshore Veterinary Specialists, 2100 W. Silver Spring Dr, Glendale. 414-540-6710. Directions from trial site: East on Good Hope Rd 3 miles to N. Green Bay Ave, turn right. 2 miles to W. Silver Spring Ave, turn right. Hospital is on the right.

PARKING/CAMPING/HOTELS: There is free parking available during the trial, but there is no overnight parking allowed by city ordinance. There are no electrical hookups on the grounds. The list of hotels is in the premium, available at www.creamcitycanines.com

REMEMBER that hotel grounds are part of the trial grounds by AKC rule. **Mistreating hotel rooms/grounds can be cause for expulsion from the trial and possible AKC suspension.**

Running orders will be posted to www.creamcitycanines.com by Tuesday night, Dec 5. You need to print your own if you want a hard copy. **Printed running orders will NOT be available at the trial.**
